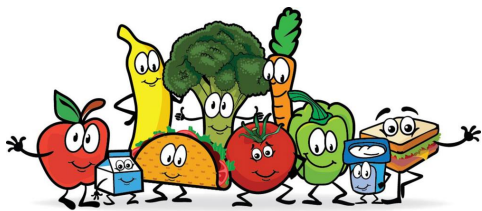

RETURNING TO SCHOOL AFTER AN ILLNESS



Please remember that students should not be at school until they have been FEVER FREE and HAVE NOT VOMITED or had diarrhea for a FULL 24 hours. Fever free does not mean fever free with medication to bring the fever down.

When students return to school sooner, they are not well enough to participate fully in learning, and more importantly with their weakened immune systems they are susceptible to catching one of the other illnesses we have seen here at school or they may infect others with what they have.

This means that a child who has been sent home with a fever and/or after having vomited at school should NOT return to school the next day.

Mom - to - Mom Sale

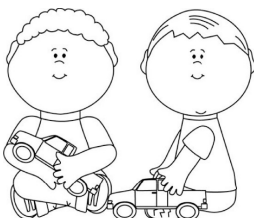

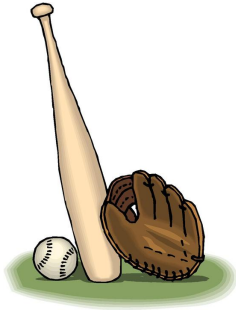
